
Watermills Park Accessibility

The Watermills Park is a lovely area to visit with a good car park and disabled parking bays. There are no toilets at this site unfortunately. The majority of the footpaths are firm, however they are not metalled and are uneven dirt with a hardcore base. In the dry I found the paths to be usable in my wheelchair, with very few gradients although a lot of the paths are not wide enough for someone to walk next to the wheelchair.















No wheelchair or mobility scooter access. You can take a longer route around.

This was a reasonably accessible route with a challenging, but not impossible surface in the dry. There are plenty of benches on the main paths for a companion to sit on, however less on the smaller paths. There are playgrounds for the children and even a Basketball court.
